**FINANCIAL DISCOUNTS AND INCENTIVES  
For the Year 2019-2020**

Helderberg College of Higher Education is pleased to announce the following discounts and incentives for the year 2019-2020.

1. New students can register for 2020 by paying at the 2019 tuition fee rate (pay at least 50%) between 1 June and 31 Dec 2019. The balance will also be paid at the 2019 tuition fee rate. This provision applies for 2020 1<sup>st</sup> semester only.
2. All new students will receive a 20% discount of the first semester tuition fees for the following programmes:  
B.Com (Accounting); B.Com in Human Resource Management; BBA (Management); BA (Communication); Bachelor of Education in Foundation Phase Teaching; Higher Certificate in Office Management (full-time only)  
**Please note:** Should the student be placed in a foundation year, this discount will be applicable for the relevant first semester.
3. One new student will get a 50% Scholarship on tuition fee, for the entire duration of the programme, for each of the programmes mentioned above.  
**Please note:** Refer to the financial brochure for the criteria that should be met.
4. Returning students will be given a 5% discount if the full semester's tuition fees are paid within the first week of registration.
5. Students whose parent/s are Church workers in SAU will receive a 35% scholarship on tuition fees, even if both parents work in the Church organization.  
**Please note:** Students in this category qualify for the discount as given in 4 and 5 only.
6. Current students can recruit new students. A fixed amount of R1000 (per new student recruited) will be credited to those students' accounts. The following conditions should be met:
  - The new student has to register as a full-time student and pay the Semester's tuition fees.
  - The name of the student who recruited the applicant should be written in the application form to qualify for the incentive.
